

Accelerate the DoD's ability to adopt cutting-edge technology from commercial and defense sectors and deliver high-impact operational solutions to the Warfighters.





Enterprise Challenges in Defense Innovation Adoption

Outdated R&D Model	Unable to effectively exploit commercial tech.
Long Timelines and Inflexible Execution	Takes over a decade to deliver major systems.
Fewer Companies Providing Defense Solutions	Industrial base shrunk 40% over last decade.
Valleys of Death	Small % of research transitions to fielded capabilities.
Hamstrung Workforce	Subject to bureaucratic culture, compliance, oversight.
Program-Centric Acquisition	Requirements, acquisition, budgets for programs.
Cumbersome Reporting from DoD to Congress	30,000 pages of budget docs – lack current details.
Limited Understanding of Emerging Tech	Struggle to adapt, leverage, defend against key tech.

Progress and Way Ahead

<u>Implementation</u> of Technology Recommendations

Modernize DoD to Align with 21st Century Industrial Base

- SECDEF elevated DIU to be a direct report
- HAC-D bill includes \$1B hedge portfolio fund run by DIU
- NDAA includes 3 new CSOs and reducing barriers to commercial solutions

Strengthen Alignment of Capital Markets to Defense Outcomes

- DARPA, Army, Navy, and AF allowed majority VC owned companies in SBIR/STTR
- NDAA directed DoD brief on impact to expand STRATFI program to Army, Navy
- * Senate NDAA extends SBIR/STTR to transfer to production Not in final bill
- * SASC NDAA \$20M Advanced Capability Pilot Program Not in final bill

Bridge Fund for Successfully Demonstrated Technologies

HAC-D bill includes \$220M for DIU to field capabilities with CCMDs

<u>Implementation</u> of Acquisition Recommendations

New Capability Portfolio Model

- ASN/RDA selected PEO IWS to explore new portfolio management practices
- HASC NDAA directs USD(A&S) to brief on implementing capability portfolio model

Increase Incentives / Reduce Barriers for NDCs to do Biz w/DoD

- SASC NDAA directs USD(A&S) to ensure KOs aware of NDC statutes and practices
- A&S established Competitive Advantage Pathfinders to identify better practices
- A&S has a Software Prime working group to engage industry on working w/DoD

HAC-D hedge portfolio fund

Modernize JCIDS/DoD Requirements

- NDAA Sec 811 includes modernizing JCIDS/DoD requirements section
- HASC directed GAO to study DoD requirements process; recommendations

<u>Implementation</u> of Budget Recommendations

Consolidate Program Elements

- Recommended by PPBE Commission Interim Report
- SAC-D bill supports intent, yet requires prior coordination ahead of FY25 PBR

Recommended by PPBE Commission Interim Report
