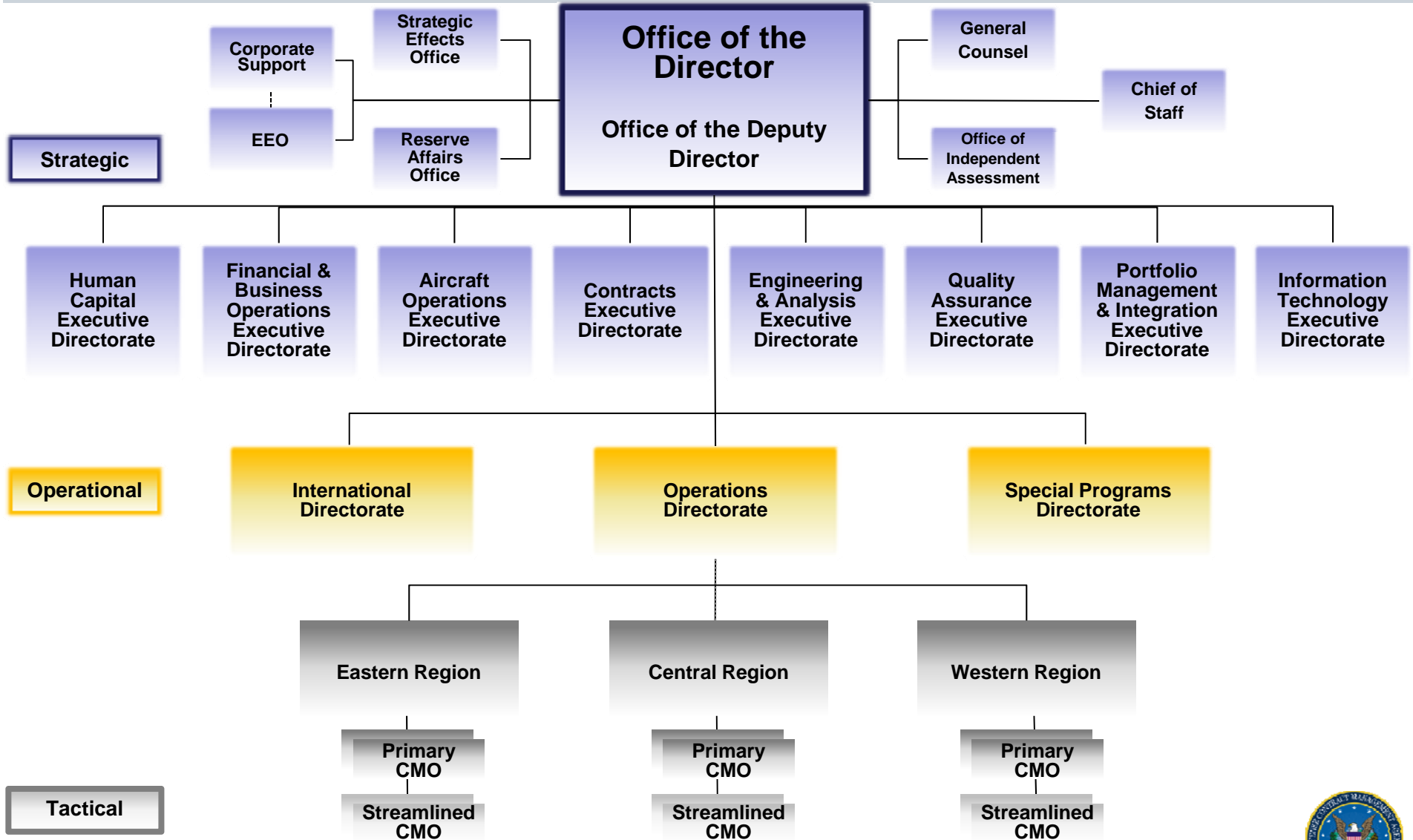

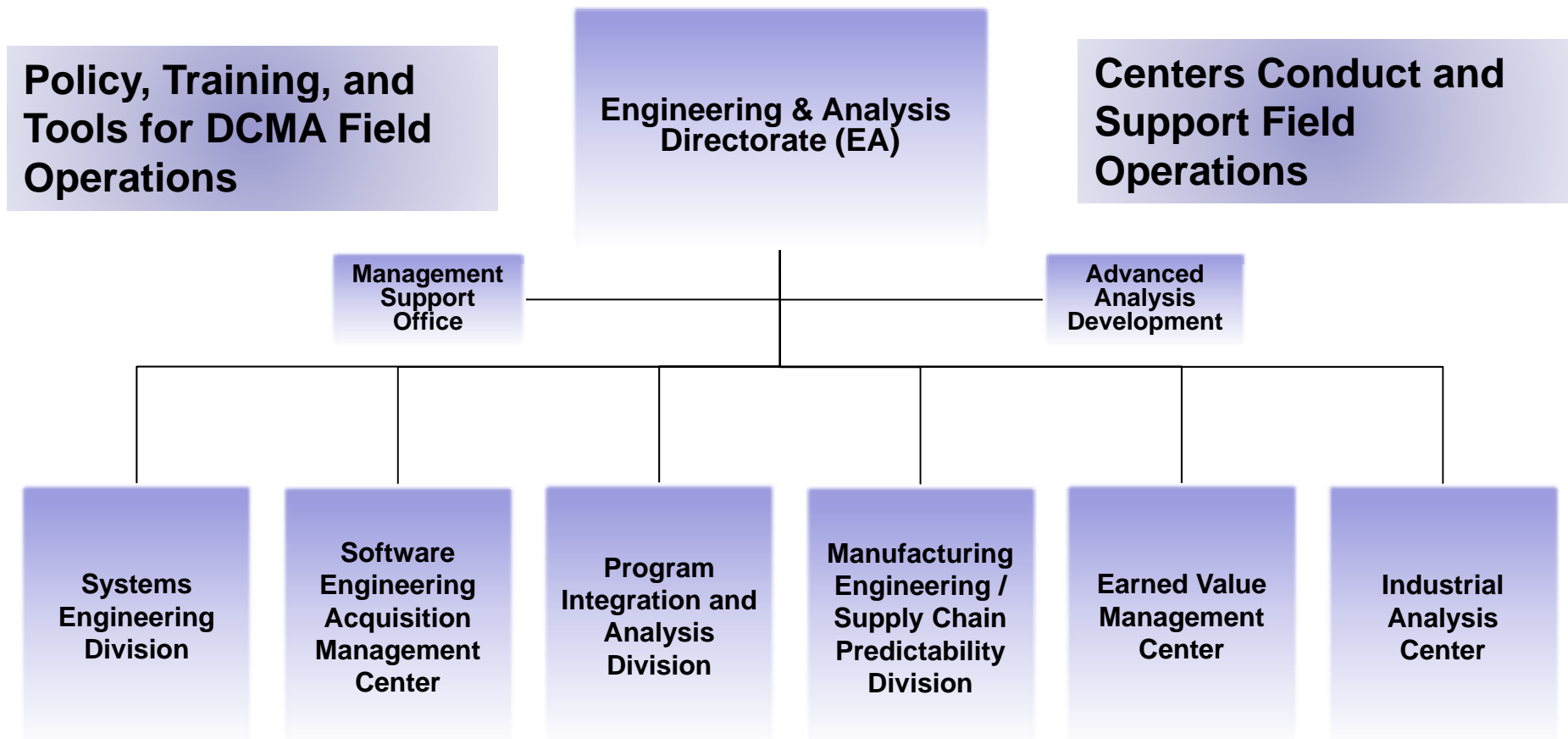


DCMA Organizational Construct 2010

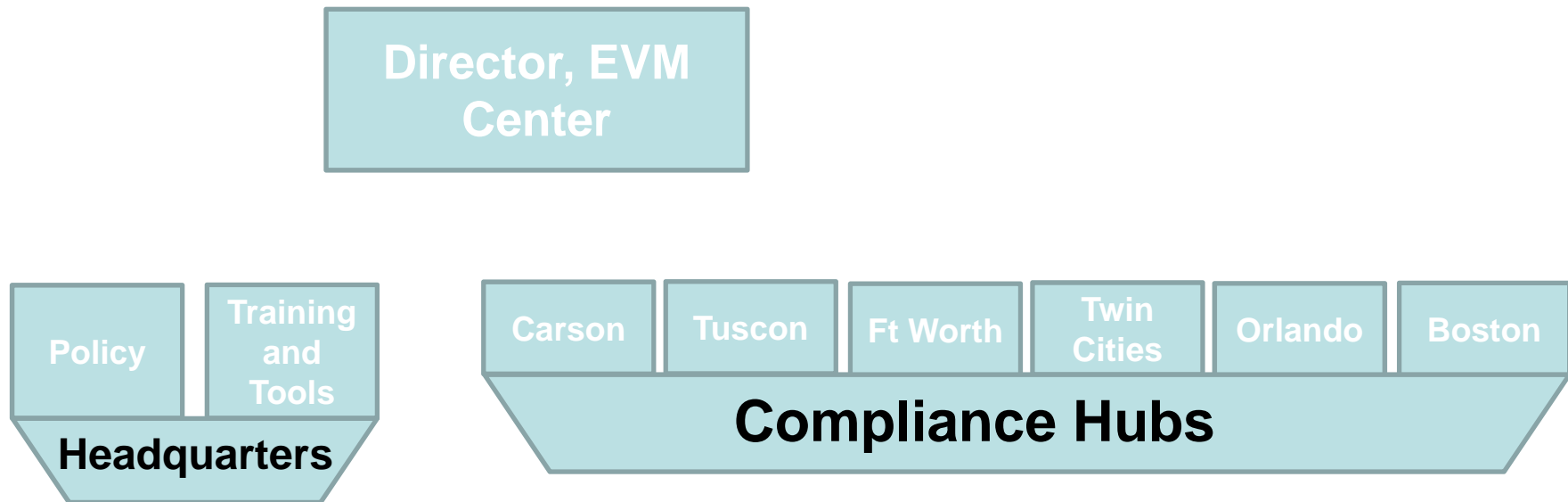

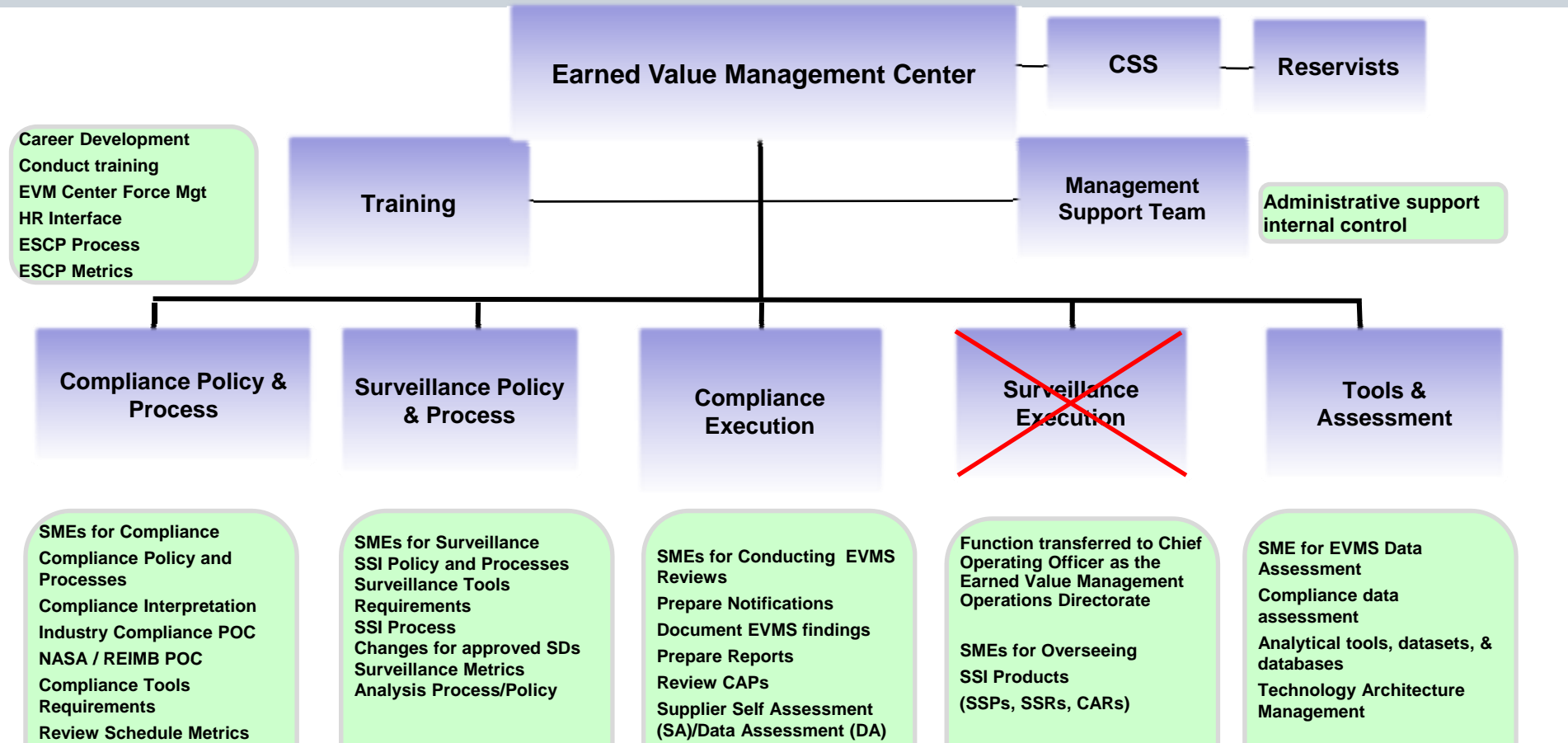


E&A Organization Chart



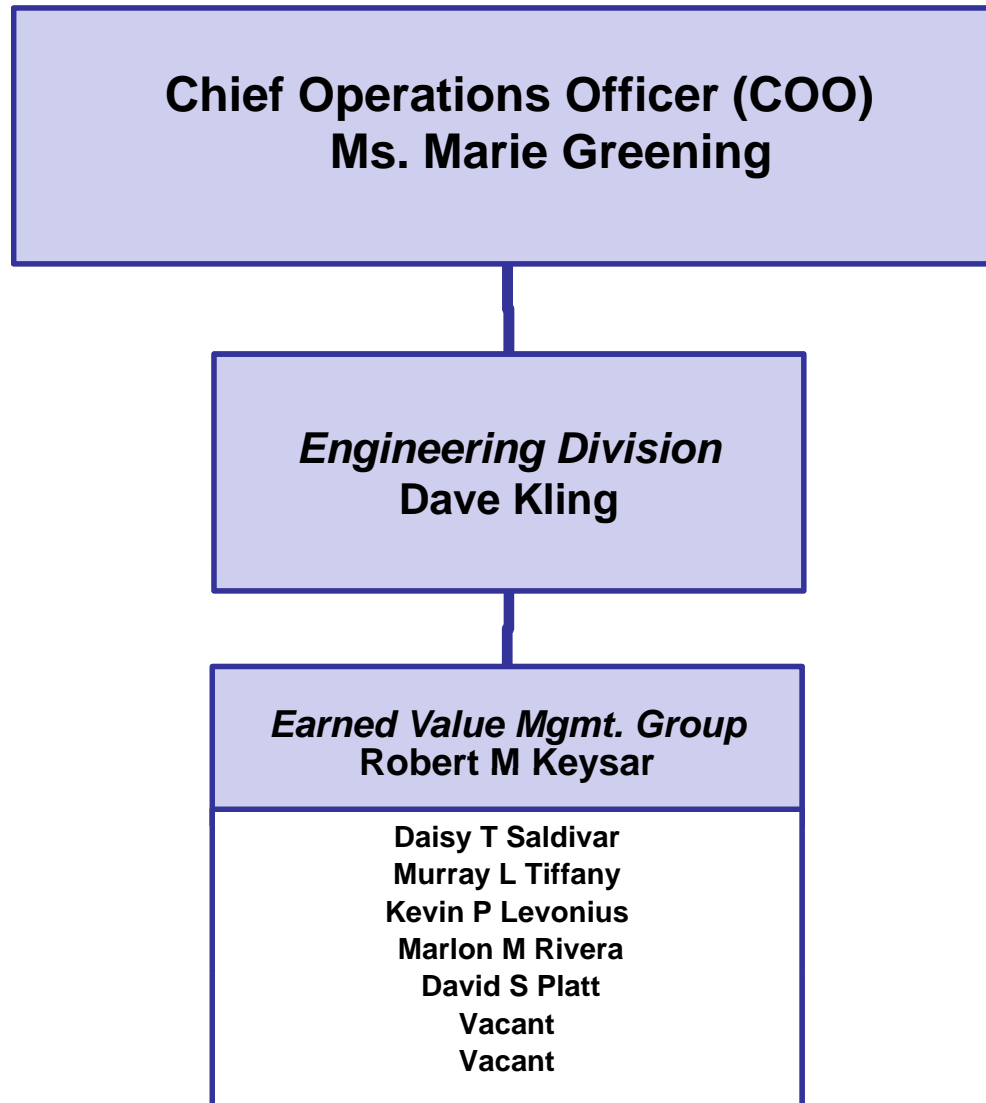
EVM Center Org Chart (Simplified/Notional)





EVM Center Surveillance Execution group is now Operations Directorate, EVM Operations Division

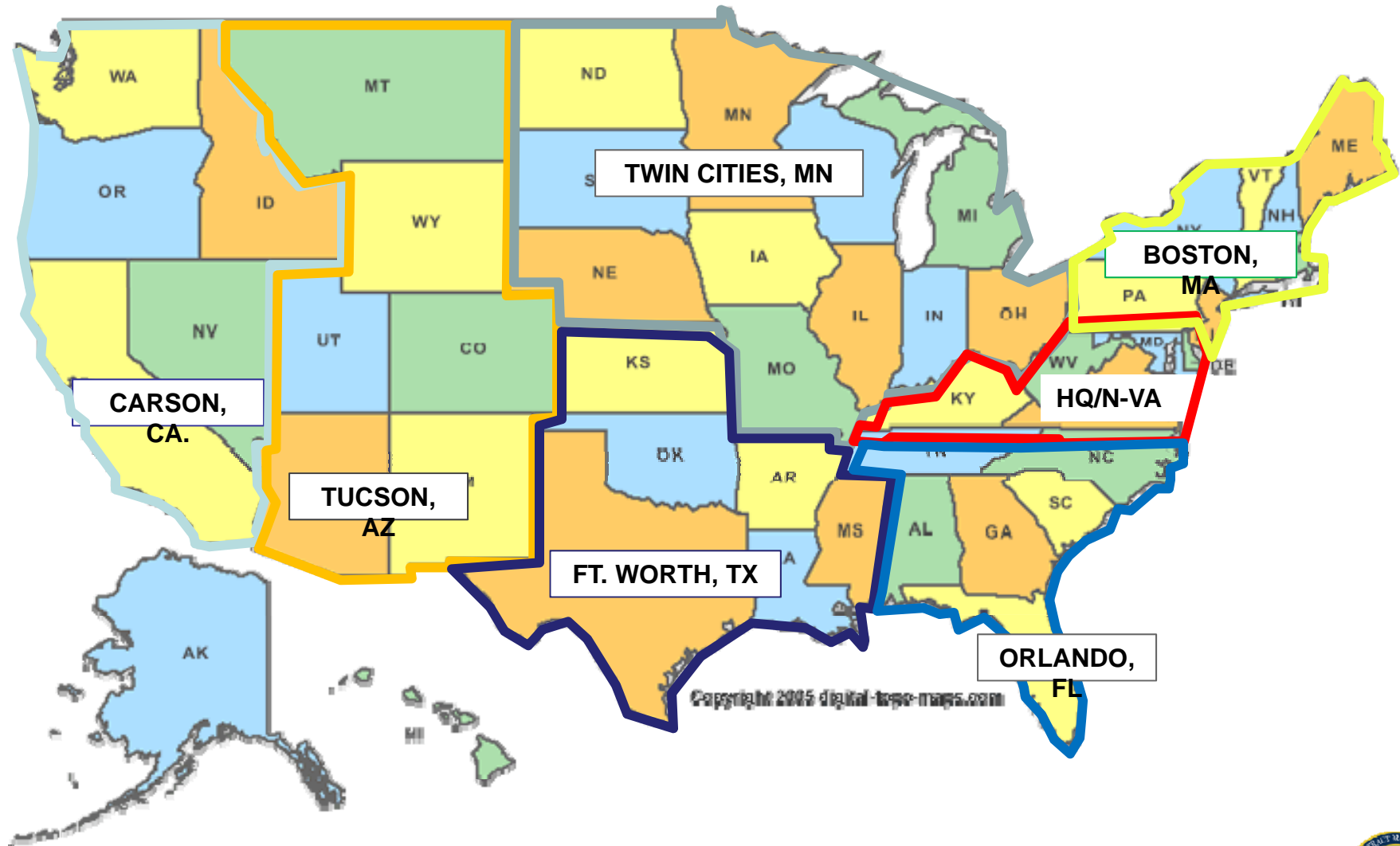
DCMA Operations



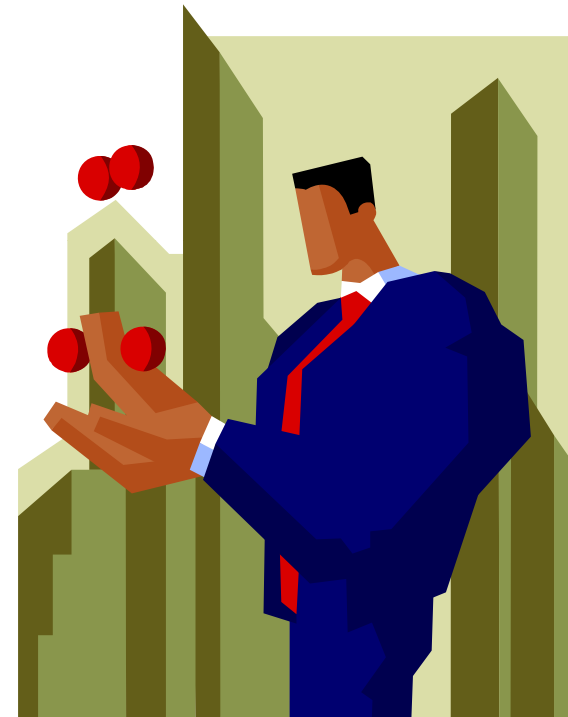

- **Provide execution oversight for surveillance policy, process, and tools**

- **Provides coordination among Sector Leads to ensure that EVM program/contract responsibilities/obligations as the DoD Executive Agent for EVMS are met**
- **Provides tracking and reports of EVMS deficiencies to EVMC resulting from**
 - **Reviews (Validation Review, Review for Cause or Post Acceptance Review**
 - **Corrective Action Requests (CARs), including tracking and resolution of CARs and Corrective Action Plans (CAPs)**
 - **EVMS issues resulting from other Regional Operations Surveillance**
