NDIA EVMS System Acceptance Guide Working Group

Background

- Initially published in November 2006
 - OMB requested NDIA take on this task
 - Recognized that an equivalent organization to DCMA did not exist to support civilian agencies
- Focus was, and continues to be, on the civilian agencies
 - Applicable to all contractors (i.e., self-assessments)
- Goal establish a common framework and standard procedure for EVMS certification and acceptance of those certifications among the civilian agencies
- A major rewrite in 2012/2013; published in 2013
- A 3 year review cycle

System Acceptance Guide Changes:

- A total of 32 comments received; mostly minor, i.e., grammar, spelling and clarifications changes
- Significant changes:
 - **Definitions** added definition of Reciprocity
 - Paragraphs 2.4 and 6.4 Added language addressing recent reciprocity situation
 - Appendix A Compliance Evaluation Review Team Selection Guidelines - changed the experience requirement for the team lead from 15 to 10 years
 - Appendix F Example of a Cross Agency EVMS Reciprocity Agreement - added
