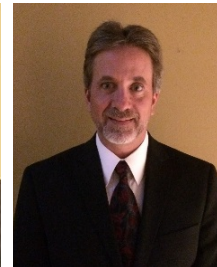

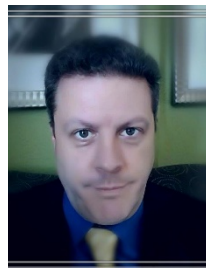

Context on How the Board Operates – What We Do Well



- **Meet in person before and after these meetings**

Context on How the Board Operates – Where We are Improving



- **Board participation and engagement**
 - Identifying creative ways to backfill exodus of past chairs – down three
 - Getting better at peer accountability for engagement
 - Revamping bi-weekly call structure to focus on performance
- **Build the pipeline of leaders**
 - Expanding Board opportunities and including WG leaders
- **Focus more time on our Working Groups**
 - We have three WG sessions for the first time with more time dedicated
- **Engage WG leaders in our Board discussions**
- **Collaboration with orgs to expand to IPM**

- **Targeted visits with focused message to gov't execs**
