



Jetco Federal, WID National Conference Past Chair, WID Michigan Chapter President

Ms. Sue Tellier is the president and owner of JetCo Federal, a prime contractor in custom crating

and packaging, warehousing, supply chain management, and logistics serving the defense industrial base that opened in 2007.

Tellier has worked in procurement marketing for the Michigan Department of Management and Budget (DMB). As DMB's head of Supplier Diversity and Business Outreach, Tellier trained more than 4,300 companies, teaching them how to bid on

and win state government contracts.

Tellier volunteers time to support the defense industrial base and advocates for small and woman-owned small businesses. She is the Immediate Past Chair of the Women In Defense National Council and the President of Women In Defense – Michigan Chapter and a long-time member of NDIA as an active participant in the Logistics Division. Sue serves on the Women Impacting Public Policy (WIPP) Board of Directors as the First Vice Chair.

Tellier serves on the board and the

executive committee for the Small Business Association of Michigan (SBAM), the largest statewide small business advocacy organization in the country. She is a gubernatorial appointee; Governor Whitmer selected Tellier to serve on the Michigan Strategic Fund, which has broad authority to promote economic development and create jobs.

#### THE HON, MELISSA DALTON

Under Secretary of the Air Force

The Hon. Melissa G. Dalton is the 28th Under Secretary of the Air Force. As the Department of the

Air Force's second-highest ranking official, she is responsible for organizing, training, and equipping the U.S. Air Force and U.S. Space Force. Dalton oversees an annual budget exceeding \$200 bn, provides air and space forces to combatant commanders in support of global military operations, and is accountable for the welfare of nearly 700,000 active duty, guard, reserve, civilian

airmen, guardians and their families.

Dalton has more than 20 years of experience in U.S. defense strategy, policy, and national security affairs. Prior to this role, she performed the duties of Deputy Under Secretary of Defense for Policy from December 2023 to May 2024 where she served as the principal advisor to the Secretary of Defense on the formation of national security and defense policy. Additionally, she served as the Assistant Secretary of Defense for Homeland Defense and Hemispheric Affairs from March 2022 to May 2024. She joined the Biden

Administration in January 2021 as the Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense for Strategy, Plans, and Capabilities.

Dalton served for more than a decade as a civil servant in the Bush and Obama administrations within the DoD, including as Policy Advisor to the Commander of the International Security Assistance Force in Kabul, Afghanistan, and more. She has extensive experience within various prominent think tank organizations including the Center for Strategic and International Studies, the Council on Foreign Relations, and the Center for a New American Security.

Ms. Jamie Miller is an experienced senior executive, trusted advisor, and skilled facilitator, with over

Miller's government service includes 13 years on Capitol Hill where she held senior staff roles including chief of staff, deputy chief of staff, and legislative director. She is the lead facilitator for the DoD Vanguard Senior Executive Leadership Program and has served on the faculty of

National Defense University's PINNACLE course for prospective joint/combined force commanders since 2018. Miller serves the House of Representatives as a consultant to members of Congress through the Congressional Excellence Program and is a life member of the Council on Foreign Relations, a member of NDIA's Board of Directors, and a member of the Blue Star Families National Advisory Board.




#### **ALEXANDRA PSARIS**

#### DR. RADHA PLUMB

Chief Digital & Artificial Intelligence Officer, DoD

Dr. Radha Plumb assumed the role of Department of Defense Chief Digital and Artificial

Intelligence Officer, a Principal Staff
Assistant to the Deputy Secretary of
Defense in April 2024. In this role she leads
the acceleration of the DoD's adoption of
data, analytics, and artificial intelligence
(AI) to generate decision advantage.

Prior to this appointment, she served as the Deputy Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition and Sustainment (DUSD(A&S)) and served the Under Secretary of Defense on acquisition; contract administration; logistics and materiel readiness; installations and environment; operational energy; chemical, biological, and nuclear defense; the acquisition workforce; and the defense industrial base.

Previous DoD assignments include serving as Chief of Staff to the Deputy Secretary of Defense and as Acting Deputy Director of Administration and Management within the DoD. She has served as the Director of Research and Insights for Trust & Safety at Google, as Global Head of Policy Analysis at Facebook, and as a senior economist at the RAND Corporation where she focused on readiness and security efforts across the DoD. In that capacity she served as lead author on reports including assessing the implications of open service of Transgender Service members.

From 2014 – 2015, Dr. Plumb served as the Deputy Chief of Staff to the Deputy Secretary of Energy, where she led policy processes to modernize our nuclear and energy infrastructure. Previously, she was the director of personnel and readiness at the National Security Council, where she was instrumental on executive actions on sexual assault in the military. She served as policy advisor and Chief of Staff to the Assistant Secretary of Defense for Special Operations and Low Intensity Conflict, and as a civilian in Afghanistan supporting the Counterinsurgency Advisory and Assistance Team for the Commander, International Security Assistance Force.

Dr. Plumb received her PhD. in Economics from Princeton University. Her research has covered empirical evaluations of policies aimed at reducing violence, including criminal violence, sexual assault, terrorist behavior, and sexual and intimate partner violence. At the outset of her career, she was an assistant professor at the London School of Economics and a Robert Wood Johnson Health Policy Scholar at Harvard.
